BACK TO BOWLS INSTRUCTIONS

ORGANISED HOME FIXTURES/COMPETITIONS/ROLL-UPS

- No rink booking – no bowling
- To book a rink call Pauline Bright on 01582 561476 or 07969 902197) who will allocate you a rink number. Please note: **Rink bookings pre 12noon only at the greenkeeper's discretion.**
- You must only use the rink allocated to you
- Organised matches will already be in the diary so roll ups will have to be outside of these times.
- Triples and fours must be on alternate rinks.
- No more than 24 people at any one time on the green in organised matches. For informal activity (i.e., roll ups), the rule of 6 applies.
- No spectators

On arrival at the green

- Arrive changed. No access to changing rooms for the time being
- Clubhouse closed except to obtain the equipment shed key (just inside the door of the men's changing room) and to use the toilets.
- Bowling bags to be placed under the awning in the designated area
- Limited number of people to use the toilet facilities at any one time (one in one out)
- Set up your rink with whatever equipment you need and put one bottle of hand gel at end of each rink. This needs to be returned to the shed at the end of your game.
- Sanitise all equipment before use
- Use hand gel frequently
- Each lead to have their own jack (suggested one yellow and one white) and they keep their own jack, maybe in their pocket, for the entire game.

After game

- All equipment to be sanitised before putting back in the shed. Replace shed key where you got it from and lock clubhouse
- Leave immediately
- Use hand gel on the way out
- Usual rotation of rinks will occur - at 6 pm green will be from clubhouse across to fence

ORGANISED AWAY FIXTURES/COMPETITIONS

- If sharing a car – individuals are requested not to face each other and occupants to wear masks if they wish.
- Please respect the Covid rules at other clubs as they may differ from ours

GENERAL

Putting names up for matches

- As the clubhouse will be closed for the time being, games will be displayed on the inside of the window facing the green
- Using small cards provided, write down your name and the game you wish to be considered for. Also write down the date you completed the card
- Place card in the relevant box marked Men's, Ladies, Over 60s, County league
- If someone is already at the window, please give them time to view the games before viewing yourself. Make sure you take a pen with you.
- Use the hand gel after use.
- Once game has been selected, it will be displayed on the window in the same way
- Please then text the relevant captain of the day that you have seen the list and confirm you are playing
- Should you not be able to get to the club, please call the Captains direct to get onto the match list:

Match Fees

- There will be no match fee for friendly games against other clubs as no food or drinks will be provided either home or away for the immediate future. Should this change, then a match fee will be charged.
- Some clubs may provide outside catering which is permitted in the roadmap from 12th April, but Barton will not be doing this as we have no outside cover in the event of inclement weather.
- Bottled water will be available at 50p per bottle to be put in the honesty box.
- No petrol money will be paid by the club for using your car to away matches as no match fees will be paid. Once match fees become payable, this will be reviewed.
